

NORTHMET PROJECT

Polymet

The Northmet Project in the northeastern Minnesota comprises an ore body containing copper, nickel, cobalt, platinum, palladium and gold, with traces of zinc and silver.

The project is anticipated to generate acid drainage that will require perpetual treatment.

YELLOW DOG PLAINS

Kennecott / Rio Tinto Eagle

Kennecott proposes to fence off 120 acres of public land for a 40 year mining project. The company has also proposed to blast under a blue ribbon trout stream, a tributary to Lake Superior.

The company is the first to apply for a metallic sulfide mining permit under Michigan's weak new mining law.

SHAKEY LAKES SAVANNAH

Aquila Resources

The site of this mine threatens Native American burial grounds, as well as the distinct savanna ecosystems that define the public recreational lands.

The ore body contains gold and zinc and is located across the border of Wisconsin and Michigan. It is along the Menominee River, which drains into Lake Michigan.
